McKenzie's Corn Roast

In cooperation with EAA Chapters 384 and IAC 88, Dave and Nancy McKenzie will be hosting their Annual Corn Roast, which will be held at their airfield "McKenzie's Landing" at 152 Gulley Rd., Howell, Michigan. This event will take place on **Saturday August 16^h, 2007** **Festivities will start at 1:00pm.** Dave notes you are welcomed to arrive at 12:00 noon to help set up. As Dave would say, "No Al-Key-hol". Please bring a comfortable chair and a dish to pass. Dave also recommends you bring your own liquid refreshments such as pop for the ice bucket. Please park on the north side of the driveway or on the road. No motor vehicles on the runway! Call Dave McKenzie at 517-545-8888 should you have any questions. If you're flying in, the coordinates are N42 36.120 W83 51.490 and the field elevation is 955' MSL. The airport identifier is 1M15. Use a south traffic pattern: left traffic for Runway 27 and right traffic for Runway 09. No flying during the peanut drop.

1. Take **I-96**
2. Take exit #**141** toward **HOWELL** - go **0.2** mi
3. Turn **L** on **E GRAND RIVER AVE** - go **1.0** mi
4. Turn **R** on **S LATSON RD** - go **1.0** mi
5. Turn **R** on **GOLF CLUB RD** - go **0.5** mi
6. Turn **L** on **GULLEY RD** - go **0.1** mi
7. Arrive at **152 GULLEY RD, HOWELL**, on the **R**
